National & County	County Health Management team, KEMSA	Procurement, Warehousing and distribution of commodities
County	County Health Management team	Oversight and resource allocation at county level
County & Sub county	DPF -District Pharmaceutical Facilitator	Quantification, ordering & reporting on commodities Provision of oversight on commodities quality issues Coordinate FP activities in the district including reporting, redistribution; training
County & Sub county	DRHCO- District Reproductive Health Coordinators	Coordinate RH activities in the district including, training, reporting, redistribution
County & Sub county	DASCO -District AIDS and Sexual Coordinator	Facilitates the provision of condoms for RH/FP programs in the district
County & Sub county	DCSC -District Community Strategy Coordinator	Facilitates CHEW's to receive commodities on behalf of the CHWs for Community based distribution(CBD)
County & Sub county	Depot managers	Quantify, order, receive, store, issue commodities to facilities Reporting on commodity issued to facilities
Facility	Service providers	Quantify, order, receive, store, dispense commodities Reporting on consumption data from the facility
Facility	Store managers	Quantify, order, receive, store, issues commodities to facilities Reporting on consumption data from the facility
Facility	CHEW's	Manage Community based distribution , by ensuring CHWs get commodities
