Proceedings of the first City level Review Committee meeting on "Review and oversee the implementation of ICDS, health, nutrition, water supply and sanitation services in Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation area" held in the BMC Conference Hall on 16th March 2012 at 4.00 PM.

Members present: As per the list annexed.

The meeting was chaired by the Commissioner, Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation. Initiating the discussion, the Slum Improvement Officer, BMC, stated that this is the 1st review meeting at BMC level to review and oversee the implementation of ICDS, health, nutrition, water supply and sanitation services in the Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation area. This was followed with discussion on various issues and accordingly decisions were taken as stated below:

1. Pre-School Education:

Child Development Project Officer (CDPO), ICDS Projects, Urban -I and II explained about the ICDS projects that are being implemented in BMC area. She stated that pre-school education in the age group of 3-6 years children is being implemented in all the 3 Urban ICDS projects in BMC area. She informed that 364 Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) with the following break-up are functioning in the city:

ICDS-I -	110 - Centres
ICDS-II -	101 - Centres
ICDS-III -	153 - Centres

She further informed that State Government in Women and Child Development Department has sanctioned 12 nos. of AWCs building to be constructed in each ICDS Project. However, she stated that due to inadequacy of space, difficulties are being faced to run the pre-school classes.

As per the request of CDPO, ICDS-I, Commissioner instructed that all the community centres in BMC area must be made available for running the pre-school education from 9 AM to 2 PM. It was also decided that CDPOs will submit a detailed list of AWCs to BMC and SIO is to share the list of community centres with the CDPOs constructed under UWEP / NSDP. In this regard, an office order may be issued by the BMC in favour of the CDPOs for use of its community centres for the purpose of running pre-school classes for the 3-6 years age group children.

2. Supplementary Nutrition programme (SNP):

After decentralization of SNP from April-11, the scheme is being implemented through Joint A/C operating by the AWW & Corporator. Morning snacks & hot cooked meal is given to 3 to 6yrs of children, pregnant women and lactating mothers (P.M & N.Ms) as per prescribed menu by W&C.D Deptt.

3. Immunization/ Health Check-up & Referral services.

CDPO, ICDS-1 stated that immunization is not taking place in all the places of the city. Health check-up and referral activities are also not being provided due to lack of coordination between ICDS, CMO, Capital Hospital and CMMO, Municipal Hospital. She further informed that "Health and Nutrition Day" is not being observed in the city. In this context, the representative of HUP-PFI, Odisha informed that discussions are being held at the state level to introduce "Health and Nutrition Day" in the urban areas of the state.

As per the suggestion of the representatives of HUP-PFI, the Commissioner instructed the SIO to issue an addendum to make the CMO, Capital Hospital, CMMO, BMC, Superintending Engineer (PH), Bhubaneswar circle and Joint Director (Technical), NRHM, Odisha as members of the committee henceforth. As per request of HUP-PFI, Odisha, it was decided that they may attend the review meeting as special invitee as they have important data to share on this matter. HUP-PFI was asked to make a detailed presentation of city level activities in the next meeting.

4. Mission Shakti:

CDPO, ICDS-1 stated that there are 1632 WSHGs having 21379 nos of members. One federation named Shakti Swarupa is functioning at BMC level to strengthen these SHGs. She further stated that WSHGs are interested to receive training under different Income Generation Activity (I.G.A) schemes.

Commissioner instructed the CDPOs are to submit proposals so that SIO can chalk out plan for imparting training under SJSRY.

5. Kishori Shakti Yojana (KSY) :-

CDPO, ICDS-1 stated that only IFA & Albendazol tablets are being distributed to the adolescent girls as per instruction of CDMO, Khordha.

6. Any other-

- City Health Officer to take steps to ensure proper sanitation facilities at the Anganwadi Centres in the city.
- Activities of NGOs implementing Urban Slum Health Projects in collaboration with NRHM, Odisha and BMC are to be monitored / evaluated by CMMO and necessary actions may be taken against those NGOs whose performance is not satisfactory.

The meeting came to an end with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
