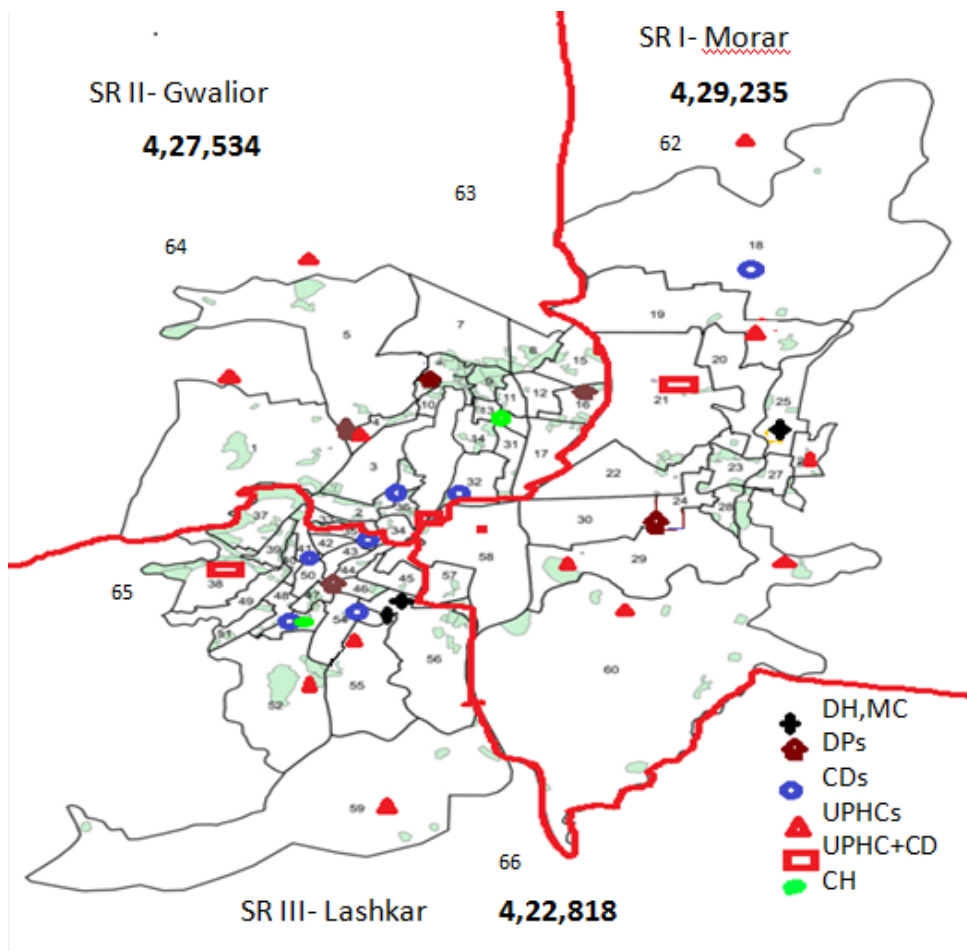


Baseline Referral Assessment Report- Gwalior

Background

According to WHO 'Health referral can be defined as a process in which a health worker at a one level of the health system, having insufficient resources (drugs, equipment, skills) to manage a clinical condition, seeks the assistance of a better or differently resourced facility at the same or higher level to assist in, or take over the management of, the patient's case'. The setting up referral mechanism enables decongestion of the health facilities, quality service delivery at primary facilities, establishing the linkage between various levels of care through defined clinical protocols and referral protocols with non-duplication of efforts and expenditure.

The population of Gwalior city is 12,96,320. As per NUHM guidelines, the UPHC/CD has to cater a population of 50,000 and a delivery point at a population of 2,50,000. Keeping the guidelines in view, the Gwalior city is divided into 3 zones with an approximate population of 4.5 lakhs each for establishing referral mechanism.



Methodology

The baseline referral assessment aimed at assessing the status of the health facilities and current mechanism of the patient flow from one level to another level of care (referral) in the Gwalior city. This assessment was conducted over the period of 2 months (from mid April, 2018 to mid-June, 2018) across the 25 facilities in the Gwalior city i.e. UPHCs, CDs and maternity homes. A structured questionnaire with quantitative and qualitative questions was used for data collection from the health facilities. Data was collected on the basic profile information of the facilities, referral processes, service provision, staffing, infrastructure, trainings, equipments/diagnostic, records and indicators.

Findings

Basic profile information of health facilities-

Other than ANMs, most of the staff was unaware about the wards covered, total population, slum population, slum area, zone number, administrative ward number, electoral ward number. Most of the facilities do not have telephonic number/contact number.

- Readiness for referral-
 - Facilities do not have clinical protocol, facility protocols, service directory and no referral review mechanism.
 - Some facilities have referral slips.
- Referral In-
 - As ASHA are placed at many places, most of them send patients directly to MH or district hospital and not at UPHC to avail services- this seems to be the disadvantage.
 - This seems to be working well for the patients as they are getting full package of services at one place and ASHA do get money for completing the case.
 - But due to this practice of referring patients directly at MH, the UPHCs are underutilized for the services.
 - Also, mainly verbal mechanisms/method is used.
- Referral out-
 - UPHCs do not have referral slips. At OPD level, a slip book is used for prescribing medicines. The same slip is used to refer the patients to further facilities. Thus we may get access to OPD level referral data from these slip books.
 - Availability of referral slips at MH. But different type referral slips formats were observed at the facilities.
- Follow-up
 - Secondly, SNs working at UPHCs seems to be dependent on ASHA's data. But at the same time the follow up of patients is done through them which may be the advantage.
 - This type of follow up is done through ASHA but no documentation.
- Counter referral
 - Almost nil
