

Why use this approach?

This approach aims to build the capacity of local government units (LGUs) to identify and adapt evidence-based interventions and mobilize resources to ensure sustained impact. It also aims to promote and strengthen collaborative relationships across government sectors—including health, education, financial, youth, gender/women's empowerment and social services—as well as between public and private organizations. TCI supports [LGUs to coordinate](#) stakeholders, bringing them together to review activities, identify gaps, and implement solutions for better use of limited resources to improve AYSRH.



STEP 1: Gather basic data and information regarding the current status of AYSRH in the city

such as adolescent birth rate, contraceptive use among adolescent parents, total population of adolescents and youth disaggregated by age, AYSRH service providers, existing AYSRH initiatives, other partners and budgets. Identify strengths and gaps. There are tools for reference from the [DOH](#), [POPCOM](#) and others.



STEP 2: Conduct an orientation on AYSRH concepts and issues among key stakeholders

to ensure greater effectiveness in allocating available resources and to invest in high-impact initiatives. Collaborate with relevant government agencies and identify next steps and a timeline for development of the AYSRH plan.



STEP 3: Establish a baseline and database for planning and budgeting

related to [illustrative indicators](#) to assess the status of the following [Philippine Youth Development Plan](#) objectives: increase in family planning uptake and safe motherhood practices, decrease in incidence of early sexual debut, teenage pregnancy, unintended pregnancy and maternal mortality. Data should be gathered through participatory approaches and existing work and financial plans should be used as a reference in determining funding sources.



STEP 4: Conduct an assessment and planning workshop among Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) officials and stakeholders

as part of the local youth development planning and investment programming at different levels using a [planning matrix](#). Follow the [ISDN Action Plan](#) and [TCI Gap Analysis](#). Match priority interventions with a corresponding budget to be sustainable, considering funds from statutory allocations, other local funds, and development partners.



STEP 5: Implement and monitor the AYSRH plan

starting with the commitment generated from all stakeholders in a partnership agreement or any functional collaborative mechanism for program implementation. Monitor and evaluate to ensure proper implementation and to determine and measure the actual results of the program compared to the goals and objectives.
